- Community Clubs** Providing safe, vibrant places where children and youth (ages 3-17) can learn, have fun and develop a sense of personal belonging and achievement. Locations: Bowness, Falconridge, Pineridge, Thorncliffe, Penbrooke and Forest Lawn.
- Beltline Youth Centre** Youth (ages 12–24) work with staff and positive adult role models to foster self-esteem through social, recreational and educational opportunities. Location: Downtown.
- Safehouse** Provides food and shelter, and helps at risk youth (ages 15–18) develop the necessary skills and courage to transition from adolescence to adulthood. Location: Downtown.
- Avenue 15** Temporary shelter for homeless and runaway youth (ages 12–17) that provides a support system to assist them in reuniting with their families or finding an alternative lifestyle and suitable living arrangements. Location: Downtown.
- Camp Adventure** Located on 64 acres, campers (ages 6-16) take part in activities such as rock climbing, hiking, canoeing, swimming, creating nature crafts, and campfires. Location: Kananaskis Country.
- Great Escapes** This outdoor program (for ages 7 and up) is all about outdoor adventures and experiencing nature! Volunteers will accompany program participants as they try new outdoor activities and have fun in a team environment. Activities will be held in and around Calgary and in Kananaskis Country at our Camp Adventure facility. Activities may include hiking, orienteering, frisbee golf, mountain biking, ice skating, snowshoeing, and cross country skiing. *This program will be launching in fall 2010.*
- Aboriginal Programs** A variety of cultural, social, educational and recreational programs for Calgary's Aboriginal children are offered at various community club locations.
- Fundraising & Special Events** Assisting with various community and fundraising events around the city.
- Administration** Assisting with mail outs, data base entries, and various clerical needs.
- Special Interest** Are you interested in running an after school or evening program? We are looking for teachers, coaches, artists, dancers, etc. that can commit once a week to an 8-12 week class to enhance our program offerings.
