The ability to work flexible hours including evenings and occasional weekends, as well as having First Aid/CPR certification is essential. A class 4 driver's license would be an asset. You also need to provide us a cleared criminal check with vulnerable sector search prior to starting work; however Criminal record check dated within 6 months of the hire date will be accepted.
