Program Descriptions

3pm-6pm Programs

Art Attack

Explore the world of art! Learn fun art techniques such as painting, drawing, and much more. Bring your creative minds to the table!

Kid Food Nation (May not register if you took this program during Winter Block)

Kid Food nation is a BGC National program! It has been created to support the development of food literacy skills in kids. In this program, participants will cook delicious food while learning skills such as balancing their diet, reading food labels, identifying fresh and healthy food, and increasing their confidence in the kitchen! ***Participants must be able to attend the entire block (11 weeks), and stay until 6pm.**

Reading Wizards

Participants will learn basic literacy skills while listening to stories, as well as engage in fun activities such as trivia and crafts related to the stories.

Bead-a-Palooza

Come down each week and make exciting and unique projects using beads. Learn to create wonderful patterns and make something you'll cherish for a long time!

Level Up

This program will explore responsible usage of different technologies including social media and video games. We will get a chance to interact with these forms of media and use them to discuss how it can effect our day to day lives?

Splash Splash

This program is partnered with the City of Calgary and participants will get to go swimming after-school at Village Square. Participants must have their swimming gear and be comfortable around the water. **Bus leaves at 3:30pm and is back at 6:15pm.**

Hobby Hoppers

Participants may discover their new favourite hobby! We will explore different hobbies such as bead-ing, painting, board games, bird watching etc. Tell us what you like to do as a hobby and maybe we can try it out!

Money, Money, Money

This program is designed to teach the kids about fundraising. As a group we will choose something we want for the club and then find a way to raise the funds to purchase it.

Spring Has Sprung

We can't wait for Spring to return so we're going to help it arrive by doing activities to celebrate Spring in all it's forms! Be ready to head outside and look for signs of Spring returning! Bring appropriate clothing and footwear to go outside!

Imagination Station

Participants will use their imagination to explore a fun mix of activities such as drama games, creating comics, and building projects!

Park Adventures

Participants will explore nature through hiking in and around Calgary. This unique opportunity will take longer than our typical afterschool time. Mem-bers will a **need a backpack with and appropriate outerwear (rain coat and/or sweater). Also bring a cold supper and wa-ter.** We **return to the club at 8:00pm.** Members must have appropriate footwear (**footwear must have laces**)—this program goes, rain or shine. Be ready for mud! **Bus leaves at 4pm.**
