In the event that a family exceeds 6 people, we will adjust the subsidy percentage based on income and individual family need.					

Families must provide proof of income from all income earners to qualify for subsidy. An income earner is defined as any person earning an income within the household and includes all income sources including employment, child or spousal support, government or organization assistance, pension, and rental income. Income is defined as gross annual household income, which is the total of all earners in the household, before applicable tax deductions and after approved expenses.

Acceptable forms of proof include income tax documents, paystubs, bank statements, rental, spousal or child support contracts, government/organization assistance documents, or a letter from a Registered Social Worker. If their current income does not reflect their previous year income, then the yearly amount will be calculated using their three most recent documents.
